SOLE TRUSTEE to hold the Fund in Trust;

The Settlers hereby declare and direct that the Trust Fund and the income thereof shall be held in TRUST by the SOLE TRUSTEE for all or any of the Trust Purposes or Objects that are set out below and including those which are incidental and or ancillary thereto.

Objects of the Trust:

To provide food shelter cloth education and employment to the poor and the needy section of the society including sick infirm downtrodden less privileged and the disabled;

- 11) To render assistance to orphaned, indigent and other less-privileged children for their subsistence, shelter education and medical care and to establish social welfare institutions engaged in promoting these specific objectives.

- xii) To bring about publications that will help promote charity and social service, the income generated if any, from which shall accrue to and form part of the Trust Fund to be utilized for all or any of the Objects of the Trust.

- xiv) To donate or subscribe or assist or support any other institutions/trust/organizations having similar objects of engaged in the field of public services, propagating the Hindu Religion and philosophy;
- xv) To impart education, technology, study, research, and allied activities, Advancement and Propagation on all Branches of Education and learning including studies and research. Establishment and maintenance of such schools and creating necessary infra-structure and imparting such education, study, training.
- xvi) To establish, maintain, take over management, administer or run any institutions, colleges engage in the imparting of education study and research to students on all or any branches of education.
- xvii) To hold, arrange and organise meetings, lectures, talks, discussions, seminars, symposia, conferences, competitions, research and study visits, tours, excursions, exhibitions, debates, cinema, audio-visual programmes, the artistic performances and other cultural activities, sports and games.

- To accept gifts donation subscription in kind or in cash whatsoever - to also obtain such exemption from whatsoever tax from the appropriate authority in this behalf and in general;
- To borrow monies on such terms and conditions and (where applicable) subject to payment of interest or otherwise as the SOLE TRUSTEE may consider necessary or desirable;
- To sell, mortgage, hypothecate, charge, lease, hire, invest or transpose the Trust investments;

To open Bank accounts and operate such

- To raise additional funds for augmenting the corpus of the Trust Fund, if necessary through appropriate programs, to support the Trust Objects.
- g. To accumulate the income of the Trust of eventual application to the Trust Objects pending which to invest the accumulation in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
- h. To employ persons and or constitute reconstitute such Committee/s, Council/s, and or otherwise engage the services of such professionals advisors as the case may be to assist the SOLE TRUSTEE in carrying out the Trust purposes. And such employee, committee, and or the Council shall hold office during the pleasure of the SOLE TRUSTEE.

8. Investment of Corpus of Trust Fund :

Subject to Clause 7(g), the SOLE TRUSTEE may invest any monies forming the whole or part of the corpus of the Trust Fund from time to time, in any securities authorized by the Indian Trusts Act, 1882 or in such other shares or securities as the SOLE TRUSTEE may in their discretion think fit without being liable for loss.

9. MANAGEMENT:

(a) The Management, control of the property and affairs of the Trust shall be vested in the SOLE TRUSTEE as aforesaid who shall have full powers and authority to purchase or hold any land or hereditament and construct any building for the object of the Trust or any building for the object of the Trust or any the John Colonian and the John Colonian an

funds or any other properties or investment at any time.

- (b) There shall be a Board of Advisors nominated by the SOLE TRUSTEE and the SOLE TRUSTEE shall be the President of the said Board of Advisors. The First Board of Advisors shall be appointed by the Sole SOLE TRUSTEE immediately after registration of this Deed. The SOLE TRUSTEE shall have the power to reconstitute the Board of Advisors at any time and to remove any individual member at their sole discretion from time to time. The SOLE TRUSTEE in consultation with the Board of Advisors shall have the power to frame such rules and regulations governing the trust in consistent with the objects of the Trust.
- (c) It shall be lawful for the SOLE TRUSTEE from time to time to frame such rules and regulations for the management and administration of the Trust and charities as they deem fit and to alter or vary the same from time to time to make new rules and regulations provided such rules and regulations shall not be inconsistent with the terms and intents of these presents and not inconsistent with the provisions of section 2(15), 11 to 13 and 80-G of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

10. Amendments:

Provided no variation, extension of amendment shall be valid if it is contrary to or inconsistent with the Trust Purposes set out in Clause 6 hereof.

11. Accounts:

The annual accounts shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant or a Firm of Chartered Accountants who shall be appointed by the SOLE TRUSTEE. The financial year shall comprise of twelve months from 1st April of one year to ending 31st march of the succeeding year; provided the first financial year of the Trust shall commence from the date of these presents and end of 31st march 2003.

Rules and Regulations ;

For the proper conduct of the affairs of the Trust, the SOLE TRUSTEE shall have the power to frame and implement Rules and Regulations which shall be consistent with the presents herein provided.

13. Dissolution:

that the Trust be dissolved such dissolution shall be effected by an instrument in writing under the hand and if after all the debts and liabilities of the Trust have been paid or provided for, there shall remain any assets, the same shall be transferred to some other organisation or association having aims or objects which in the opinion of the SOLE TRUSTEE are similar to all or any of the Trust Purposes.
